On July 6, 2020, the San Francisco Police Department's Special Victims Unit (SVU) opened a missing person's investigation regarding Dawn Manson who drove to San Francisco in June of 2020 to stay with her boyfriend. After losing contact with Manson, her mother reported her missing.

On July 7, 2020, the SFPD investigator assigned to the case received word from Manson's mother that Manson was in Southern California.
