

San Francisco Police Investigators Are Seeking Second Vehicle Involved in March 2nd Excelsior District Collision 21-054

On March 2, 2021, at approximately 12:52 PM, San Francisco Police officers from the Ingleside District Station responded to Mission Street and Geneva Avenue regarding an auto versus pedestrian collision.

Arriving officers located a 79-year-old female pedestrian in the roadway. Officers rendered aid and summoned paramedics to the scene. The pedestrian was transported to Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (ZSFGH), where, despite the lifesaving efforts of the medical staff, she later died.

The driver of a red Honda sedan, an 83-year-old female, San Francisco resident remained at the scene and is cooperating with the investigation. Impairment is not considered a factor in this investigation.

Investigators from the SFPD Traffic Collision Investigation Unit (TCIU) are seeking a second vehicle that may have been involved in a collision with the Honda prior to the Honda striking the pedestrian. The second vehicle is described as a 2010-2014 black, Ford, four-door, Raptor pickup truck with tinted windows. The Ford may have right rear damage from a collision with the Honda.

The owner of this vehicle and the person who was driving it on March 2nd is asked to call TCIU Investigator Sgt. Luis Oliva at 1-415-553-1641.
