On April 28, 2022, at approximately 10:15 am, San Francisco Police Officers assigned to Southern Station responded to the 300 block of 2nd Street on a report of a bank robbery.

Officers met with a teller from the bank who said that a male suspect approached her teller window and passed a note to her. The note said that the suspect was robbing the bank and demanded money. The teller complied and gave the suspect US currency. The suspect then fled the scene.

Responding officers and investigators located an individual matching the suspect description, and the suspect was identified by witnesses. The suspect was identified as Rockey Marino, a 41-year-old-resident of San Francisco. Rockey Marino later confessed to the robbery.

Rockey Marino was booked at San Francisco County Jail for Robbery (211 PC), Burglary (459 PC), committing a robbery while out of custody on a pending robbery case (12022.1(b)PC), three warrants out of San Francisco, and two warrants out of San Mateo County.
