On Thursday, August 3, 2023, at approximately 9:43 p.m., dispatch received a 9-1-1 call from a person advising they had been shot. Officers arrived on scene at the unit block of Kelloch Street and located a 22-year-old male victim, who was later identified as Relondo Jacori Bell, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Officers rendered aid and medics responded to the scene.

Medics transported Bell to a local hospital for life-threatening injuries. Despite the lifesaving efforts of emergency responders and the hospital staff, Mr. Bell succumbed to his injuries.

The investigation is being led by the SFPD Homicide Detail.

The Volkswagen Tiguan depicted in the attached photo is suspected of involvement in the shooting of Mr. Bell. It has been recovered. Investigators are seeking information about the individual(s) associated with this vehicle.

The San Francisco Police Department has increased the amount of a reward issued in December 2023 from \$25,000 to \$125,000 for information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Relondo Jacori Bell.
