### **Aggravated Assault w/ Gun Arrest**

July 16, 2018 - **unit block Carr** (SFPD 180529332)

Officers responded to a call of an armed suspect who had threatened the victim with a handgun. The officers were able to locate and arrest the suspect and recover the firearm.

### **Firearm, Shots Fired Arrest**

July 17, 2018 - **700 block Missouri** (SFPD 180434349)

Officers identified the suspect involved in a June firearm discharge incident and located him at his home. The suspect was taken into custody and two firearms were seized from the residence.

### **Robbery**

July 17, 2018 - **Silver / Girard** (SFPD 180532539)

A suspect assaulted the 42 year old victim and stole her cell phone and bank cards prior to fleeing the scene. This incident is being investigated by the Robbery Detail.

### **Robbery**

July 17, 2018 - **Silver / University** (SFPD 180533383)

A suspect ran up to the 34 year old victim, snatched her cell phone away, and off. This incident is being investigated by the Robbery Detail.

### **Robbery**

July 18, 2018 - **3rd / Palou** (SFPD 180534442)

A 33 year old victim was riding on a MUNI LRV when a fellow passenger assaulted him and went through his pockets, stealing his cell phone. The suspect got off the train and fled the scene. This incident is being investigated by the MUNI Task Force.

### **Auto Burglary Arrest**

July 20, 2018 - **unit block Wheat** (SFPD 180527966)

Officers investigating a suspect regarding a stolen vehicle and a separate auto burglary located him as well as property, stolen in the auto burglary, in his possession. He was arrested and the stolen property was reunited with the auto burglary victim.

### **Shots Fired**

July 20, 2018 - **Jennings / Le Conte** (SFPD 180539745)

Officers responded on a call of shots fired but located no victims or damage. Review of surveillance footage from the area showed a suspect firing a round at an occupied vehicle which drove off. The victim vehicle came back around and the driver had an interaction with the suspect before both parties fled. No injuries were reported as a result of this incident, which is under investigation.

### **Armed Robbery**

July 21, 2018 - **Quesada / Quint** (SFPD 180541596)

Two victims, ages 22 and 29, were approached by the suspect who robbed them of their wallets and phones at gunpoint. One of the victims was pistol whipped by the suspect prior to fleeing the scene. This incident is being investigated by the Robbery Detail.

### **Armed Robbery**

July 23, 2018 - **300 block Executive Park** (SFPD 180548837)

Officers responded to the area regarding robbery with a gun. The suspects approached the 26 and 38 year old victims after parking behind them. The suspect stole the victims' cellular phone and camera. One suspect pointed a firearm at the victims. The suspects fled the scene in a gray sedan. This incident is under investigation.

### **Robbery Attempt**

July 23, 2018 - **3rd / Evans** (SFPD 180549120)

Officers responded to area regarding an attempted robbery with a gun. Two suspects approached the 47 year old victim and one of them pointed a gun at him. The victim grabbed the gun but the suspect pushed him to the ground and grabbed the gun back. The suspect punched the victim and fled the scene. The Robbery detail is investigating this incident

### **Firearm Arrest**

July 24, 2018 - **Newcomb / Newhall** (SFPD 180551329)

Officers conducted a traffic stop on a reckless driver. During their investigation, officers located a firearm that was hidden in the vehicles air vent. The suspect,

a known Tre-4 Gang member, was arrested and booked. Gang Task Force is investigating the incident.

### **Homicide**

July 24, 2018 - **700 block Kirkwood** (SFPD 180552054)

Officers responded to the scene and located the victim in a vehicle with multiple gun shot wounds. The 23 year old male victim was transported to the ZSFGH where he was pronounced deceased. The Homicide Detail is investigating this incident.

### **Firearm, Burglary Arrest**

July 25, 2018 - **1500 block Yosemite** (SFPD 180552236)

Officers responded to the area regarding an attempted burglary of a legal marijuana grow. Officers detained four subjects. Upon completing their investigation, the officers arrested the four suspects for attempted burglary. Officers also located a firearm in the suspects' vehicle. They were booked on attempted burglary and conspiracy charges and one had was charged with additional firearm violations.

### **Commercial Robbery Arrest**

July 27, 2018 - **300 block Bayshore** (SFPD 180559470)

Officers responded to a call of a robbery with a knife. Officers located the suspect nearby and recovered the box cutter, that she had used to threaten the employees in the course of the robbery, on her person. After completing their investigation, officers arrested the suspect for robbery.

### **Shooting**

July 27, 2018 - **Oakdale / Baldwin** (SFPD 180560574)

Officers responded on a call of shots fired and located evidence of a shooting. Two victims who had suffered gunshot wounds, ages 18 and 20, transported themselves to ZSFGH for treatment. Gang Task Force is investigating this incident.

### **Shooting**

July 27, 2018 - **3rd / Evans** (SFPD 180560790)

Officers responded to the ZSFGH regarding a 19 year old shooting victim being treated for his injury. Through their investigation, they determined the identity of the suspect and arrested her soon after. The Special Victim's Unit is investigating this incident.

### **Stabbing**

July 28, 2018 - **unit block Bertha** (SFPD 180562116)

Officers responded to the area regarding a person who had been stabbed. Officers located the 35 year old victim who suffered a laceration to his arm. The victim reported that the suspect stabbed him with a pocket knife after the two became involved in an altercation. The victim became uncooperative and refused to provide further information. The victim was transported to ZSFGH for treatment.

### **Firearm Arrest**

July 29, 2018 - **Francisco / Taylor** (SFPD 180565154)

Officers arrested the suspect for a parole warrant and conducted a search of his vehicle. During the search officers located a firearm. The suspect, an associate of the "Oakdale Mob" street gang, was booked on weapons and parole violations. Gang Task Force is investigating this incident.

### **Aggravated Assault with Knife Arrest**

July 29, 2018 - **1400 block Keith** (SFPD 180565972)

Officers responded to the area regarding an assault. As a result of their investigation, officers arrested the suspect for hitting the victim on the head with a skate board and cutting him on the wrist with a knife. The victim was treated at ZSFGH.

### **Robbery w/ Gun, Shooting**

July 29, 2018 - **Jamestown / Harney** (SFPD 180565847)

Officers responded to ZSFGH regarding a 22 year old shooting victim. Officers learned the victim was robbed of his cell phone by the suspect who then shot him in the stomach. The victim is expected to recover. The Robbery Detail is investigating this incident.

## Dispose of Unwanted and Expired Medication at Bayview Station

There is a new secured bin at Bayview Station where you can dispose of unwanted and expired medication at any time of the day or night. The bin will accept any type of prescription and off the shelf medication **except** for:

- **Herbal Remedies**
- **Vitamins**
- **Supplements**
- **Cosmetics**
- **Other personal care products**
- **Compressed Cylinders**
- **Aerosols**
- **Inhalers**
- **Medical Devices**
- **Sharps**
- **Illicit drugs**
- **L odine containing medication.**

When disposing the medication, please leave it in the original container with your personal information crossed out or removed. You can also place the medication into a clear plastic zip top baggies. Contact the front desk officer and inform them that you want your medication dispose



of. The officer will assist you.

Please note that once an item that had been disposed of inside the bin, we cannot retrieve it. So make sure your ring, cell phone or anything of value is not accidentally disposed of.

With over 2,300 different telephone numbers listed to access local government services, many people did not know what number to dial to reach the appropriate department. Now you can connect to city services with only two numbers to remember: **911** for emergencies and **3-1-1** for everything else.

Before 311, over 50% of calls to the 911 center were not emergency related. **311** relieves 911 operators from these non-emergency calls. If a catastrophic emergency such as an earthquake occurs, **311** operators will be able to provide accurate information to assist during the recovery. In the unlikely event the 911 facilities becomes inoperative, the **311** call center will function as a back up.
