Investigations Reorganization

The Department's Investigations Division is in the process of reorganizing its approach and response to criminal investigations. The goal of the reorganization is to provide a more efficient, structured, and enhanced approach to investigating crimes. To achieve these goals the Investigations Division is reorganizing investigative response units. With this reorganization, units responsible for investigating crimes will be adjusted and the role and the responsibility of some investigative units, including Station SIT, will change. The Investigations Division will reorganize with the below units. Once the reorganization is complete, the role and responsibilities for each unit will be defined and announced.
