Elder Abuse (EA) and Child Abuse (CA) Radio Suffix Codes
(Re-issue DB 11-033)

The Division of Emergency Management (Dispatch) uses suffix codes EA (Elder Abuse) and CA (Child Abuse) in order to identify specific circumstances related to the call for service. These suffix codes are to be used like the DV code is used for Domestic Violence incidents.

Elder Abuse and Child Abuse are defined by the Family Violence Council as follows:

- o **Elder Abuse-** Physical and/or financial abuse committed against elders and dependent adults. The SFPD defines an elder person as 65 years old or older.
- o **Child Abuse-** Sexual and/or physical assault cases committed against children under the age of eighteen (18) years old.

Dispatch (DEM) broadcasts calls for service with the EA and CA suffix codes if this information is available at the time of the initial call. In the event that the EA or CA suffix code is not already attached to a call for service, the member shall notify Dispatch to add the appropriate suffix code of EA or CA upon the completion of the call for service.

The below listed calls for service have had the EA (Elder Abuse) or CA (Child Abuse) suffix code enabled in CAD:
