Faxing of Muni Related Incident Reports to Muni Response Team

To help determine the most current and effective deployment of the San Francisco Police Department's resources for MUNI related incidents, members shall **fax a copy of all MUNI related incident reports to the Muni Response Team.** Members shall fax all incident reports regarding any serious incidents or crime related incidents on MUNI buses, light rail vehicles, cable cars, MUNI property, bus stops, MUNI platforms and transit stations to the Muni Response Team as soon as possible after the incident. Members shall indicate the bus/rail line number, the time frame of the incident and whether the Muni vehicle was equipped with a safety camera in the narrative portion of the incident report.

Sergeants and Platoon Commanders reviewing these incident reports shall ensure the reporting officer is in compliance with this bulletin.
