The San Francisco Police Department has authorized a \$25,000 reward for information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the suspect responsible for the murder of Mitchell Davis Warren pictured above.

On September 30, 2016, at approximately 4:30 a.m., a shooting occurred near the southeast corner of Polk and Ellis Streets in San Francisco. The shooting resulted in the homicide of Mitchell Warren. The suspect was captured on surveillance video and is pictured in two photos above. The Family of Mitchell Warren is seeking closure to this tragedy. The San Francisco Police Department is offering a reward to individuals who provide information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the killer.
