Medical Liaison Transfers and Temporary Modified Duty Assignments

Sworn members who have been on Disability Pay (DP) in an excess of 30 days shall be transferred to the Medical Liaison Unit. The Medical Liaison Unit shall be responsible for ensuring that these transfers are completed. Sworn members whose Workers' Compensation claims are on delay, denied, or who are off work because of an approved leave *shall not* be transferred to the Medical Liaison Unit. Civilian members *will not* be transferred to the Medical Liaison Unit under any circumstances.

When a sworn member is cleared for full duty, the Medical Liaison Unit will coordinate with the member's current, temporary unit *and* the member's permanently assigned unit to ensure that the member's transfer can be processed with minimal disruption. If a member has been on DP in an excess of 6 months, the Medical Liaison Unit will coordinate with the Field Operations Bureau and the member's current, temporary unit to facilitate a minimally disruptive transfer of the member to their "Re-entry to Patrol" assignment.

Any member who has medical restrictions or who has advised the Department that they cannot perform all of the essential job functions of a sworn member, shall notify the Medical Liaison Unit through their chain of command. The Department will attempt to place the member in a temporary modified duty position in accordance with the procedures in Department General Order 11.12. The Deputy Chief of the Administration Bureau will make the final decision regarding the availability of a temporary modified duty assignment.

Members are reminded that under no circumstances shall a member contact a supervisor, Officer-in-Charge, or Commanding Officer of any unit in an attempt to arrange for a temporary modified duty assignment. No supervisor, Officer-in-Charge or Commanding Officer shall offer any assignment of modified duty to a member.
