#### **Application for the SFPD Leadership Development Institute**

(Supersedes DN 20-146)

Beginning in January 2022, the San Francisco Police Department will launch the fourth Leadership Development Institute (L.D.I.) cohort. The L.D.I. will offer leadership education to members (sworn and professional staff) in order to provide professional and personal development and enhance leadership at all levels. The Department is proud to offer this education in partnership with Blue Courage and the San Francisco Police Officers' Association.

The mission of the L.D.I. is to develop shared leadership through interdependence and teamwork and provide members with the heart-set and mindset to lead ourselves and each other in both formal and informal leadership settings. Through facilitated discussions, open, respectful dialogue, dynamic engagement, and shared experiences, each student will have an opportunity to develop through a positive learning environment:

- A clear sense of purpose and meaning for their lives
- A language of leadership that enhances awareness and accountability
- A sense of curiosity to disrupt mediocrity and challenge the status quo
- The capacity to be more resilient in times of stress and adversity
- A clear pathway to mastery of the skills required to thrive in personal and professional relationships

The L.D.I. will consist of 12 sessions; the hours will be 0900-1700 hours. The attire for the training is business casual.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

All sworn and professional staff of the San Francisco Police Department are eligible to apply. It is the goal of the L.D.I. to comprise 80% of each cohort with Officers, Sergeants, and Professional Staff.

If a member applied prior to L.D.I. in 2020, please reapply and indicate you applied prior in the relevant application field. Please contact the L.D.I. Coordinator Officer Broderick Elton #320 if you need a copy of prior submitted material; otherwise, submit the application packet again.

The following is required to apply:

- Completed application (see attached)
- Current professional resume (detailing education, training, experience within SFPD)
- Cover Letter to answer the following questions:
  - 1) Describe what you hope to gain from this training experience.
  - 2) Describe how you envision your leadership role in the SFPD, both in the present and in the future.
  - 3) Describe your leadership philosophy and style and what you have done to foster it.
  - \*Maximum of 300 words per question allowed

All required items listed above need to be scanned and e-mailed to **SFPD.LDI@sfgov.org**. In addition, members shall "CC" their commanding officer.

Completed application packets (sent by e-mail) are due no later than 21 days from the date of this notice.

Hard copies of the application packet can be sent to Officer Broderick Elton #320 of the Training Division/Police Academy.
