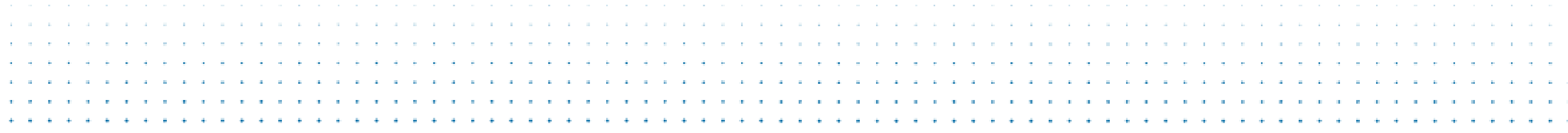

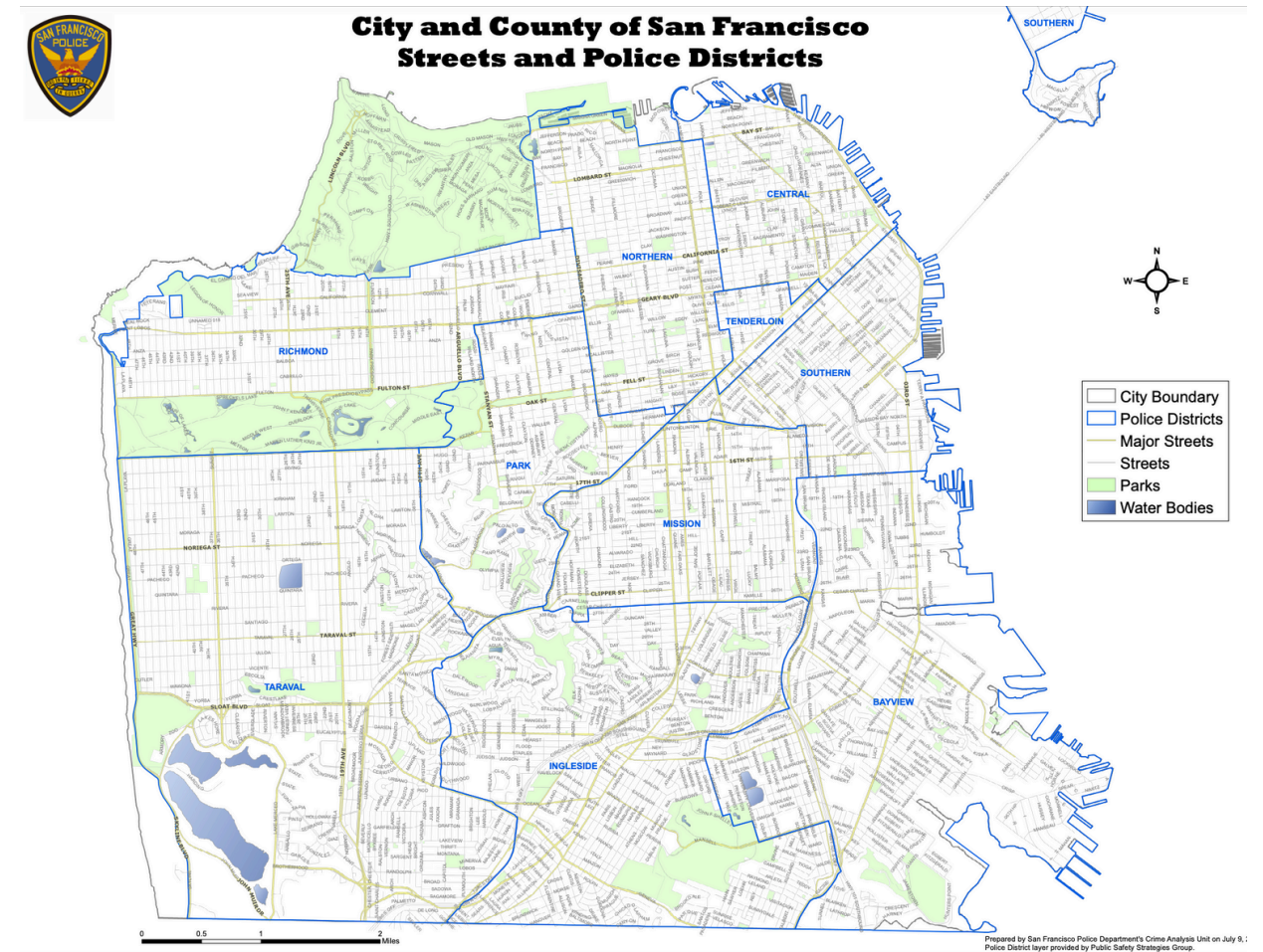

METHODOLOGY

Emerson College Polling conducted a survey of San Francisco residents, commissioned by the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD). The sample size for the total sample is N=1,065, and each of the ten police districts has a sample size of n=107.

Data was weighted by San Francisco city parameters. The credibility interval, similar to a poll's margin of error, for the overall sample is +/- 2.9%; each police district has a credibility interval of +/- 9.5%. The survey was administered via cellphones via MMS-to-web, an online panel, and a consumer list of emails. Data was collected between September 23-30, 2024.



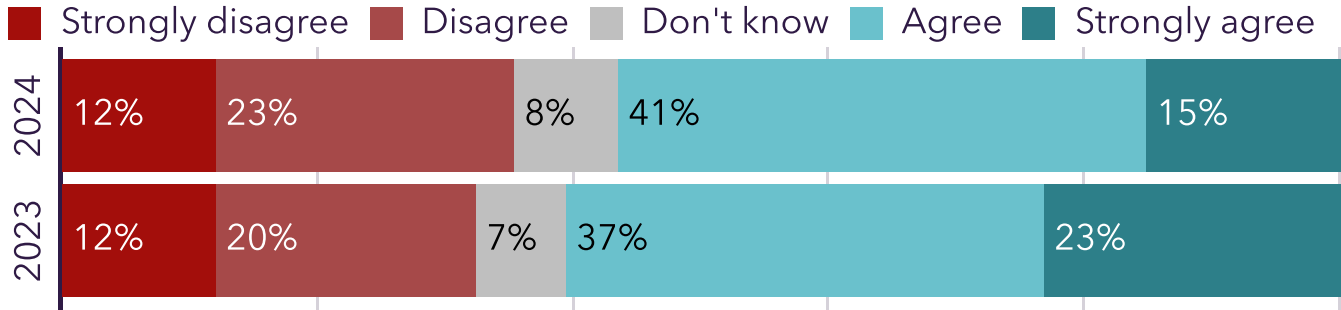
